SURREY JUNIOR FLOWER ARRANGERS

STEP-BY-STEP DESIGN - VERTICAL DESIGN (floral foam free)

YOU WILL NEED:

- > A tall pot/container, such as a plant pot around 10-12cm diameter and 15-18cm height with polybag inserted if there is a hole in the pot, to avoid any leakages on to furniture -
- Some lengths of aluminium wire (any colour) to coil and crunch into your pot/container the wire should come up inside the pot to near the top in order to support your design a few small stones or gravel in your pot will add actual weight so your design doesn't topple over be very careful not to tear the bag as you insert your wires (check for any holes allowing water to seep through)
- Foliages in order to form your upright line a few straight twigs such as Cornus or plain attractive tree twigs, or any other straight line plant material such as a couple of Phormium leaves ::: also a little filler foliage such as Hebe, Euonymus, conifer ::: and also four/five bold leaves such as Ivy, Hosta, Bergenia, Heuchera -
- Flowers smallish head flowers such as 1/2 stems Lisianthus, 2/3
 Carnations, 2/3 Iris or any similar size and texture of flowers ** please see note below -



Ensure all plant material has been in water at least a couple of hours, for a good drink - after having recut (about 2cms) the stems if you have purchased from a supermarket or florist shop - before starting to arrange - **(supermarket flowers used were what was available with flower shops closed)

INSTRUCTIONS

Place your twigs/Phormium leaves straight and upright just behind the centre point of the coiled wire - avoid the lines of your plant material crossing over one another if possible - height of tallest plant material should be approx. twice the height of your container - take a look at the visual balance of your leaves or twigs when in place -





Use your bold leaves to cover up what is seen of the crunched wire in the top of your container - in different planes to create visual depth, also round the back of your design to create visual balance -

Place flowers into design, with smallest flower at the top point, grading medium and larger flowers/or more flower heads down your design towards the opening of your container, creating a focal point at the base where you have positioned your bold leaves - fill in any gaps round the wire with your filler foliage stems - (the outline visual of your design should look like a sharp-pointed pyramid)

Fill almost to the top of your container with clean cool water - position your design in the corner of a room, or wherever it will be seen and enjoyed - but not in a draught or near a radiator -
